**Wednesday, November 11, 2009**

**Linda Niessen, DMD, MPH – Dallas, TX – AM: “Aging Successfully: Oral Health for the Prime of Life”** Aging successfully includes a healthy dentition. For today’s adults over 50, oral health means more than disease treatment. The program will review changes associated with aging and diseases and how they affect oral health. The objectives of this program include examining common medical conditions and the medications patients take that increase their risk for caries, periodontal disease and other oral problems such as xerostomia and root caries. **PM: “Women, Witches and Wisdom: Update on Women’s Oral Health”** This program examines oral health throughout a women’s life. From puberty and adolescence through young adulthood to middle and older adults, this seminar will discuss oral diseases and systemic conditions and medications affecting girls and women from the common (Pregnancy, heart disease, diabetes, arthritis, osteoporosis), to the uncommon (eating disorders, Sjogren’s syndrome, TMD, domestic violence). Dr. Niessen currently serves as Vice President, Chief Clinical Officer for DENTSPLY International. She holds a faculty appointment as Clinical Professor in the Department of Restorative Sciences at the Baylor College of Dentistry. This course is a must for dentists and the entire staff. **Thursday, January 14, 2010**

**Mark Murphy DDS – Rochester Hills, MI – AM: “Immediate Load Implant Retained Overdentures”** Dr. Murphy will familiarize you with the research, development and implementation of simplified small diameter implant placement in your general practice. You will learn an evidence based and risk assessment protocol for placing and restoring immediate load implants and doing the overdenture prosthetics (featuring Sterngold ERA implants). He will compare systems for resiliency, familiarity, efficacy and predictability. Dr. Mark Murphy is the Vice President of Educational Services for Mercer Advisors and serves on the Faculty of the Pankey Institute for Advanced Dental Education and on its Board of Directors and Trustees. **James Ellison, CDT – Attleboro, MA – PM: “The Precision Prosthesis for RPD’s and Implants”** In the afternoon, James Ellison will join in a presentation that will cover the proper use of intra- and extra-coronal attachments including a demonstration documenting several of the more popular attachments systems. The ERA attachment will be highlighted. Next, the segmenting of fixed bridgework will be presented, including those attachments used with non-parallel abutments, and those used in future conversion to removable prostheses. Special attention will be given to those attachments used with implants. Mr. Ellison is the Director of Technical and Educational Services for Sterngold and has lectured worldwide. **Wednesday, April 14, 2010**

**Bernard Touati, DDS – Paris, France – “Esthetic Integration of Digital-Ceramic Restorations on Implants and Natural Teeth”** Today’s great challenge on teeth and implants is to develop natural-looking and harmonious soft tissue that mimics that of the adjacent teeth. Since implant treatments are presently biologically-driven, we must consider in every case the importance of tissue preservation to limit unaesthetic tissue remodeling around implants. Presently metal-free restorations both on teeth and implants combine strength, biocompatibility, aesthetics and longevity and can be fabricated via CAD-CAM technology. The objectives of this course are: To evaluate anterior implant sites and determine if (and how) one must preserve or regenerate, to “advance plan” implant esthetic cases for shorter treatment and better outcome, to learn more about all-ceramic restorations and modern CAD-CAM technology and to achieve predictable esthetic outcome in difficult situations (dark substrates, metal posts and cores, etc. . . .) Dr. Touati is a Past-president of the European Academy of Esthetic Dentistry, Founder-past president of the French Society of Esthetic Dentistry, Member AAED, and Editor-in-Chief of “Practical Procedures and Aesthetic Dentistry”. Experience this rare appearance by Dr. Touati in the US. This course is co-sponsored by a major educational grant from Nobel Biocare. **Wednesday, May 19, 2010**

**Peter Jacobsen, PhD, DDS – San Francisco, CA – “The Art of Dental Therapeutics: Dental Drugs and Over-the-Counter Dental Products”** This course will update you with the latest information on a wide range of prescription drugs and over-the-counter dental products in order for you to better address your patients’ questions. It will also discuss the various “active ingredients”, allowing you a better understanding of oral care products which will be useful for your patients. You will learn: how to choose the most current, effective topical and systemic antiviral drugs for patients with herpes virus infections, the newest drugs for fungal infections, aphthous ulcers, sinusitis, and other oral cavity/head and neck problems, the advantages and disadvantages of the various types of pain medication and the best trial of medication to prevent pain before it starts, the range of compounds available in single-purpose and multi-purpose toothpastes, and the range of products and treatments for patients with dry mouth. Dr. Jacobsen has his Phd. in Pharmacology and directed the oral medicine clinic at the University of the Pacific School of Dentistry. He is a diplomat of the American Board of Oral Medicine and past chair person of the council on dental therapeutics of the ADA. Bring the entire clinical team!
