Click on the More tab at the bottom of the app screen. Then click on Settings.




Click on Account Details at the very top.





There you will see your initials in a circle and your profile information below. Click on Edit to add your photo.




At the bottom you will see your choices for selecting your photo. You can take a photo or select one from your photo library.











Once you find the one you like, follow the prompts and click SAVE at the top right corner.

Voila! Your picture will now be associated with your name throughout the app.









Membership Card >>>


Once you've downloaded PDA Go - your ADA/PDA membership card is always with you! 2019 was the last year that the ADA actually printed membership cards, so having this attached to PDA Go makes it an even more valuable tool.

- 1. Open the app and click on the "More" icon at the bottom of the page.
- 3. Tap on "Member Card."
- 2. Tap the "Profile" tab outlined in red.





4. Your information appears here along with all of the important phone numbers you may need. Tap on them and call right from your device!



Events >>>

Managing your schedule of events (both in-person and virtual) with PDA is made super easy with PDA Go.

1. Open the app and go the Events tab at the bottom of the screen. Here you will see a complete list of events in chronological order.

2. When you see the event you have registered for, tap "Add to schedule".

If you want others to know about this event, tap "Share" and the member directory will appear.


You can only share with other app users with this feature.




3. Choose where you would like to see this event.

Bookmarks >>>


Do you ever see an interesting post in the News Feed, but just don't have the time to read it at that moment?


No worries! The bookmark feature allows you to mark it and find it again easily, without having to scroll through the news again.

3. Go to your Profile under the more tab.

1. Open the app and go the News Feed post that you want to save.

2. Tap the "Bookmarks" tab outlined in red. After you tap it, it changes to "Bookmarked".






- 4. Your saved items now appear in the "Bookmarks" window below your name and will remain there as long as you need them.
- 5. When you no longer need the item bookmarked just go back to the News Feed and tap "Bookmarked". It reverts to "Bookmark" and is removed from your profile window.

Using Tags in PDA Go >>>

Most of us have become accustomed to using a search bar from time to time. It prevents endless scrolling and gets us what we want to know quickly.

With the latest update to PDA Go, you now have the option to search *by topic* in the News Feed. See below.


Open the News Feed tab and you will see something like this. The red arrow shows you the new "Tags" feature.






So you want to search for news we have posted and tagged as #ADA. After you tapped on "Tags" you will see all of your options in alphabetical order. You can choose more than one, and a simple tap checks the box and click "Done".

The News Feed will appear showing the number of tags you selected and all of the news items that have been tagged as such. You can see this below with the two red arrows. Pretty cool?







Troubleshooting PDA Go

Technology is great as long as it works, right? We completely agree! PDA has several staff members monitoring the app for both the Android and Apple devices. Chances are, if you're having an issue, we know about it. Here are a few suggestions for troubleshooting:

Q: When I logged in, it said my username and/or password was incorrect.

A: Your app username and password will be the same as your PDA website credentials.

Q: If I change my information in the app - does that mean it changes on the website, too?

A: Yes, it does and vice versa!

Q: I forgot my username or password

A: Follow the app's direction to email med@padental.org

Q: The app screen is stuck like the screen to the right

A: While we hope this doesn't happen often, if it does, please know that the app development team is aware. They are working to eliminate this issue.

Q: An error message pops up after the screen to the right

A: Take a screenshot! This allows our development team to get a better idea of what's happening. Please follow the instructions to send to our staff member, listed out in the bullet points below.



If the issue persists or you cannot solve the issue with the above information after 48 hours, please reach out to Michelle Berrones at mmb@padental.org and provide the following:

- A description of problem
- A screenshot or screen recording of the issue
- Device type ie. Android or iPhone
- Device version ie. 8Plus or X
- Software version ie. 13.0.1 (you can Google how to find this)
