

From the Executive Director

This is PDA's first post-pandemic annual report. Of all that transpired in that challenging time, the event with the most enduring impact may have been our sale of the Bell Insurance Agency (a.k.a. PDAIS). The deal PDA made placed the association in an exceedingly strong financial position. Nearly two years later, non-dues revenue has actually increased reserves are way up and members still have a benefit from Bell/PDAIS since PDA maintains an endorsement relationship with the agency.

When looking just at 2022, though, a few key numbers pretty well sum things up:

- \$50,000 = amount PDA contributed to the successful effort to pass a medical loss ratio referendum in MA, setting key precedent for the rest of the country.
- \$10,000 = amount PA Dental Foundation donated to assist Florida dentists recovering from Hurricane Ian.
- \$5,516 = annual savings members typically realized after switching to **Best Card**, the PDA Member Advantage credit card processing company, in the first full year (2022) it was available to PDA members.
- 8 = transformative ideas considered by the new Innovative Projects Task Force seeking to identify superior ways
 to invest in new member benefits (The PDA board should soon be asked to fund at least 1 or 2 of these).
- 3 = hours of CE credit PA dentists can receive for providing pro bono care following passage of Act 159 of 2022 (SE 1173).
- 1 = event "takeover" by members to mark the 2022 debut of PDA's Instagram page.
- 0 = no. of dollars PDA members still pay to get Act 31 and Act 124 required CE credit.






